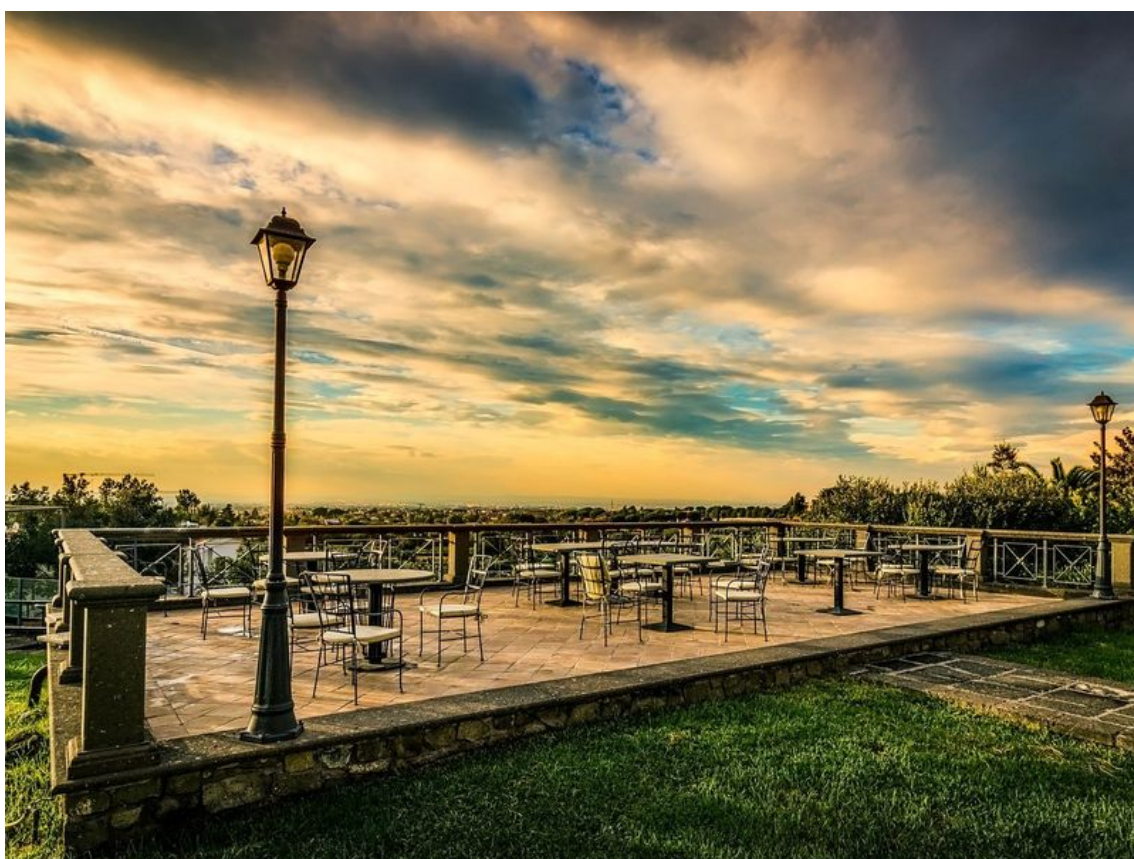

Discover three of Italy's most cultural cities. Savour Rome's rich heritage, soak up the Renaissance atmosphere of Florence, and look beyond the canals and gondolas to gain a deeper understanding of Venice.

1° Day: WELCOME TO THE ETERNAL CITY OF ROME

Rome is the former religious, political and commercial heart of a vast empire. Arrival at Rome's Fiumicino Airport and transfer by private bus to your Hotel.

2° Day: ROME

Breakfast and meeting with your local guide and enjoy the very best of the city's highlights including a tour at the Vatican Museums, culminating beneath Michelangelo's famous ceiling in the Sistine Chapel. The visit ends with the visit of the magnificent St. Peter's Basilica. In the afternoon the visit goes on with the spectacular Trevi Fountain, don't forget to throw a coin in the beautiful fountain as you are guaranteed to return to Rome if you do; Navona Square, Spain Steps and the Pantheon.

3° Day: ANCIENT ROME

Breakfast and meeting with the local guide. The visit proceeds to the ancient Rome with the Roman Forum and the grand ruins of Colosseum, also known as Amphitheatrum Flavium. Afternoon free time for your own visits and shopping.

4° Day: UMBRIA / TUSCANY

Breakfast. Journey through the picture-perfect scenery of the Tuscan hills, where deep-green cypress trees pierce blue skies and olive groves hug the rolling hillsides. Stop for a tasting for local products and wine. Arrival in Florence.

5° Day: FLORENCE, BIRTHPLACE OF THE RENAISSANCE

Breakfast and meeting with local guide. The visit starts with Duomo or Cathedral of Santa Maria del Fiore, the baptistery and bell tower, piazza della Signoria (open air museum), exterior of the famous Uffizi Gallery and Ponte Vecchio the old bridge. The joys of Florence are varied so the afternoon will be free for your own personal exploration.

6° Day: PISA AND ARRIVAL IN VENICE

Breakfast and drive to Pisa to see the incredible Leaning Tower. See also the splendid Cathedral and Baptistery, before continuing to the romantic city of Venice.

OR:

6° Day: VERONA AND VENICE

Breakfast. Passing the city of Bologna, a highlight stop is the elegant city of Verona, legendary home of the Shakespeare's star-crossed lovers. Walk with local guide past the Roman Arena to the reputed famous balcony in the courtyard of the Capulet home. After free time to explore, the tour continues to Venice.

7° Day: VENICE AT LEISURE

Breakfast and transfer to Tronchetto to catch the private ferry to St. Mark's Square. See the Basilica, the Doge's Palace and the Bridge of Sighs. In the afternoon free time in Venice for your own visits and shopping. Return to Tronchetto by boat and transfer to the Hotel by bus.

8° Day: ARRIVEDERCI

Bid farewell to Bella Italia. Transfer to Venice Airport.
